Mr. Gabel:

On December 22, 2022, you made the following request for records:

"...copy (via email attachment) of the application submitted to the Division of Ecological Restoration's Priority Projects Program by the town of Wellfleet (or its agent) to support the Herring River Restoration Project. Please include all attachments, including (but not limited to) letter of commitment from the property owner, copy of the latest assessor's map, project photo, design plans, letters of support from the community, permits, and press and media coverage."

In response to your previous records request submitted on November 29, 2022 which requested "all grant applications" to the "town of Wellfleet in support of the Herring River Restoration Project", DER provided the only grant/priority project application from the Town of Wellfleet associated with the Herring River Restoration Project. The Herring River Restoration Project was nominated as a Priority Project by the Town of Wellfleet under a 2004 Request for Responses (RFR # ENV 04 CZM 04) administered by the MA Office of Coastal Zone Management Wetlands Restoration Program (CZM-WRP). The Project was awarded Priority Project status at that time and has maintained that status as the project has advanced through its development phases. In 2009, the CZM-WRP merged with the Department of Fish and Game's Riverways Program to create the Division of Ecological Restoration in the Department of Fish and Game. At that time, all of CZM-WRP's active Priority Projects (including the Herring River Priority Project) were transferred into the Division of Ecological Restoration's Priority Projects Program.

After a reasonable search, DER is unable to locate any additional records responsive to your request. For your convenience, we have attached Wellfleet's 2004 Priority Project application.
